



## DAILY BIBLE READINGS FOR DECEMBER

The gospel readings for the month of December, 2023, are centered mostly in Mark, with scattered readings from Matthew, Luke and John. For instance, the first two Sundays draw from Mark, Chapters 13 and then 1: The coming of the "son of man;" and the Proclamation of John the Baptist. The season of Advent offers some of the most beautiful and compelling texts in the Bible. Of course, we read the same texts for Christmas Eve each year: Isaiah 9:2-7, Psalm 96, Titus 2:11-14, & Luke 2:1-20.

The Hebrew/Old Testament texts for Advent come from Isaiah. Enjoy the variety of readings leading up to and including Christmas Eve.


