Epistle Lesson: Acts 8:26-40

Introduction; In Acts, we find Philip, guided by an angel of the Lord, embarking on a divine encounter on a desert road that leads from Jerusalem to Gaza. Here, Philip meets an Ethiopian eunuch, a high official under the queen of Ethiopia, who is struggling to understand the scriptures. This passage highlights the Spirit's role in breaking cultural and ethnic barriers, showing God's message of salvation reaching beyond Jewish boundaries to touch all nations.


